Ordinance 227

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL PARKING REGULATIONS AND PENALTIES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF CHRISTIANA, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 205.

AMENDMENT TO PART 4, SECTION 15-400. GENERAL PARKING REGULATION

15.411 PENALTIES - ENFORCEMENT.

It shall be the duty of police officers of the Borough to report to the Police Chief all violations of any provision of this Ordinance, indicating in each case the section violated, the license number of the vehicle involved in the violation, the location where the violation took place, the time and date of the violation, and any other facts that might be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances attending the violation. The police officer making the report shall also attach to or place upon every such vehicle a notice stating that the vehicle was parked in violation of this Ordinance. The notice shall contain instructions to the owner or driver of the vehicle that if he shall report within ten (10) working days to the Christiana Borough Police Office during normal business hours and pay the sum set forth, or mail the sum set forth to the Christiana Borough Police Department, so that it is received within ten (10) days after the time of the notice, that act will save the violator from prosecution.

Penalties for the following violations will be set by Resolution so as to allow for changes from time to time.

1. No Parking Zone
2. Loading Zone
3. Parking less than 20 feet from an intersection
4. Parking less than 15 feet from a Fire hydrant
5. Parking double/Obstructing Traffic Lane
6. Parking in Handicapped Zone
7. All others

Any person who violates any other provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay the penalties or fines set forth in the Vehicle Code or elsewhere in this Ordinance for violations of such nature, together with costs of prosecution.

If the notice of violation is not satisfied within ten (10) days, a letter sent by first class mail shall be issued by the Police Department and an additional five dollars (\$5.00) shall be applied to the penalty. If the violation has not been satisfied within thirty (30) days after it has been issued, then the violator shall be prosecuted.

The provisions of this amendment and addition are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held to be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of the Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been enacted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance Amendment and Addition shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption and approval as provided by law.
