

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHRISTIANA
LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Ordinance No. 218

An ordinance of the Borough of Christiana, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, amending Section 202 of Ordinance No. 205 adopted June 5, 2007, and restricting Elizabeth Street to one-way passenger car traffic between Railroad Avenue and Green Street.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Christiana enacted Ordinance No. 205 on June 5, 2007, establishing, *inter alia*, one-way streets for various highways within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds it desirable to restrict the flow of traffic on Elizabeth Street between Railroad Avenue and Green Street.


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained and Enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Christiana, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 202 of Ordinance No. 205 of the Borough of Christiana, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, is hereby amended and Elizabeth Street is hereby restricted to one-way traffic between Railroad Avenue and Green Street with traffic only permitted in an eastward direction. Operators of motor vehicles shall abide by all applicable local and state traffic codes and ordinances;

The Borough staff is hereby directed to erect, install and maintain appropriate signs as designated in the Borough Engineer's Traffic Engineering Study in compliance with PennDOT specifications.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its enactment date identified below.
